ARMADA FAIR CAMPGROUND RULES & REGULATIONS

Water and Electric Hook-Up Modernized Camping: <u>\$250 for the week</u> Primitive/Rustic Camping: <u>\$35 per day</u>

1. Upon review and approval of applications, campsites will then be issued only to out of town large livestock exhibitors, fair officials, and vendors. Employees or volunteers (other than officials) are not allowed to camp. Superintendents have the right to deny anyone not meeting all criteria.

2. Please let the Committee know of any special needs as soon as possible.

3. No sleeping tents allowed. All campers must be on wheels and travel worthy.

4. No dumping of any wastewater, potential fine up to \$500.00 per day from the Macomb County Health Department. Water leaks of any kind will not be tolerated, use hose washers or other hardware.

5. No campfires, open flames, fire pits, torches, etc.

6. No golf carts, UTV's, ATV's, etc.

7. No parking next to campers. Roads and driveways must be kept clear at all times for emergency response access. Park in general parking only. Violators will be towed at the owner's expense, no exceptions.

8. Campsites are to be issued only to a person age 21 and above. Parents/Guardians must always supervise minors.

9. Each modernized campsite includes one weekly parking pass. Primitive campers must purchase daily/weekly parking.

10. Quiet time is 10 pm. Loud music, shouting, fighting, or excessive noise of any kind will not be tolerated at any time.

11. Campers must maintain a clean site during the fair for safety purposes and upon departure, campers should use dumpsters provided.

12. Campsite pass or tag will be issued upon arrival and will include the following: campsite number, name of registered camper, and phone number to be reached during fair. Camping sticker or tag must be displayed on camper door or nearest window by door.

13. Modernized campsites cannot be vacated early, unless deemed necessary by superintendents in charge or in handicapped areas.

14. Primitive campsites are allowed generators but must be turned off from the hours of 11PM to 6AM.

15. All campers will be parked in straight lines, no "corrals" or "circle camping."

16. No extra appliances to be plugged into camper. Ex: No refrigerators, roasters, fryers, smokers, etc.

17. Please list all dimensions of your camper, including slide outs.

18. Camping area will be patrolled by security personnel, which includes police presence.

19. No open intoxicants. No underage drinking. This will be grounds for removal.

20. Camping is a privilege, and permission will be revoked for persistent disturbance.

Failure to adhere to the above rules, by all persons on site – including guests, will lead to expulsion from the campground without refund. The person that registered the camper is responsible for all guests and their actions.
